- nausea, stomach pain, low fever, loss of appetite, dark urine, jaundice (yellowing of the skin or eyes);
- fever, chills, body aches, flu symptoms;
- · coughing up blood or vomit that looks like coffee grounds;
- pale skin, easy bruising or bleeding, unusual weakness;
- · feeling short of breath even with mild exertion;
- · swelling, rapid weight gain;
- · urination more or less frequent than usual;
- sudden headache or pain behind the eyes.
